The Guymon Oklahoma Police Department reported that they had closed down Main Street or U.S. Highway 412/State Highway 136 in downtown Guymon between 4th Street and 7th Street due to flash flooding from the very heavy rainfall. No damage or injuries were reported.

Severe thunderstorms in the central and eastern Oklahoma Panhandle produced wind damage and hail along with isolated flash flooding during the early evening hours. The high winds caused power outages across the Tri-County Electric Cooperative service area with approximately one thousand and seven hundred members without power during the storms. Downed power poles caused the longest outages in Turpin Oklahoma and on the northeast edge of Guymon Oklahoma. No injuries were reported.
