The dry spring pattern continued into the first half of April for the Oklahoma Panhandle. There were a few scattered rain events early in the month, though most areas measured less than 0.10 inches of rain through April 15th. Several widespread rain events affected the Panhandle in the second half of the month, however; and most locations ended up receiving at least 1 to 1.5 inches of rain for April. This beneficial rain fell mostly across the eastern Panhandle and southern portions of Cimarron and Texas Counties. As a result there was improvement to Severe (D2) Drought conditions in the central and eastern Oklahoma Panhandle, while conditions worsened to Extreme (D3) Drought in the western Panhandle. Guymon recorded 1.46 inches of precipitation (0.05 inches below normal) during April.

Soil moisture was rated from mostly adequate to short by the end of April. Prior to the onset of spring rains, dry and windy weather had left most soil moisture rated as short. The rain was too late to save some winter wheat, though did help to ensure a good moisture profile for spring planting of summer crops in many areas. Rangeland and pasture improved throughout the month, though cattle herd sizes remained limited due to prolonged drought and high cattle prices. Upper soil zones were mostly above 40 percent full by the end of April, with top soil in the western Panhandle in the 10 to 20 percent full range (moderate agriculturally dry). Deeper soil ranged from 30 to 50 percent of normal in the western Oklahoma Panhandle to between 70 and 100 percent of normal across the eastern Panhandle. The Palmer Drought Severity Index indicated a rating of Near Normal conditions for the Oklahoma Panhandle. No countywide or statewide burn bans were in effect.

Streamflows and reservoir levels across the Oklahoma Panhandle were below to much below normal during April, resulting in moderate to extreme hydrologic drought.

Economic losses due to the drought through April were predominantly the result of losses in winter wheat and supplemental feed for cattle on drought-thinned rangeland and pastures.
