Heavy rain from thunderstorms resulted in flooding in Vega during the late evening of the 21st through the early morning hours of the 22nd. Water invaded 11 homes in Vega and some streets were flooded, including Highway 385.

A severe thunderstorm caused wind damage in the town of Dodson in Collingsworth County during the evening of the 21st. Earlier that afternoon, storms occurred further west in the southwest portion of the Texas Panhandle, but were non-severe. Hail, strong wind gusts, and heavy rain were all that was reported. As the night went on, heavy rain continued in some locations. This resulting in flooding in some areas. Flash flooding was reported in Vega where flood waters invaded 11 homes. Streets were impacted by flood waters, including Highway 385 through Vega. Minor flooding of streets throughout the city of Amarillo was reported. Rainfall amounts at many locations ranged from 2 to 3 inches.
