Heavy Snow

A low pressure system moved rapidly out of Alberta Canada moving along the Canadian/North Dakota border then slowed, becoming nearly stationary and intensified over northeastern North Dakota during the early morning hours on October 24th 2001. The storm system brought a general 2 to 5 inches of snow across central North Dakota with isolated 6 to 9 inches in northcentral North Dakota.

In Willow City, in Bottineau county, received 8.6 inches and 6 inches fell along the Canadian border 13 miles north...northeast of Bottineau. The same storm system brought blizzard conditions to eastern North Dakota that day
