A deep low pressure system moved through the Northern Plains which pulled cold air into the Dakotas. Some light freezing rain developed early in the day on December 4 over the James River Valley, with a transition to snow around mid-day. This combined with winds gusting as high as 55 mph to produce a blizzard.
