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Numerous branches were downed by thunderstorm winds, northeast of Athens. No snapped or uprooted trees.

Isolated strong thunderstorms developed during midday across north Alabama. One storm knocked down a large tree limb in Madison County. During the mid to late afternoon, a broken line of thunderstorms developed in northwest Alabama and southern Tennessee. These tracked east through north Alabama during the late afternoon and early evening hours. One of the storms knocked down or uprooted numerous trees in eastern Limestone County, and produced sporadic tree damage as it moved into northern Madison County.

Five to seven inches of rain fell across the Spanish Fort area in under a three hour time frame. A CoCoRaHS observer reported 6.78 inches of rain in Spanish Fort. This heavy rainfall resulted in the flooding of roads in the Timber Creek subdivision with cars stalled in the streets. In addition, the heavy rain caused a roof to collapse at the Caterpillar trucking plant.

A series of thunderstorms developed along outflow boundaries, producing a long duration of heavy rainfall across the Spanish Fort and Daphne areas of the Eastern Shore in Baldwin County.
