Drought conditions continued to worsen over central Alabama with Extreme Drought (D3) conditions developing across portions of east central Alabama. Below normal rainfall and above average temperatures continued across central Alabama with several counties added to the Severe Drought (D2) category. Observing sites in the Severe to Extreme Drought category were near 10 inches below normal rainfall for the year.

A microburst produced widespread tree and power line damage along Jackson Road. Dozens of trees were uprooted and snapped with at least 10 power poles damaged. A resident in the neighborhood measured 58 knots with a Davis Instrument Wind Sensor.

A quasi-stationary cold front was positioned just north of the I-85 corridor. Scattered thunderstorms developed along the front during the afternoon. One of the storms produced a microburst over Elmore County.
