This comma-head tornado touched down on the southern edge of an open field off of Dallas County Road 143, just north of Sixmile Creek. There were a few large pine limbs snapped at this location, while to the north side of this open field it caused more significant tree damage with a few trees snapped or uprooted. It moved north-northeastward, intensifying and growing quickly before reaching its maximum intensity of a 400-yard-wide 95 MPH EF-1 as it crossed CR 405. A van and a truck were overturned in a church parking lot, with the truck tumbling about 50 feet and the van tumbling into, but not snapping a power pole. The tornado continued to uproot and snap trees as it moved northward for several hundred yards, but then began to lose strength just as quickly as it had intensified. The tornado weakened as it curled under the comma-head and dissipated along CR 37 just north of Gibbs Rd.

The National Weather Service surveyed damage consistent with a low-end EF-0 in northwest Barbour County. The tornado touched down just west of CR 9 near the Mays Rd intersection. The tornado continued north crossing Star Hill Rd where a small outdoor shed was damaged along with a few softwood trees. The tornado quickly dissipated shortly thereafter.				
Deep-layer ridging over the Southeast United States held up a trough over the Central United States for the first few days of April, leading to a prolonged and significant severe weather and flooding event from Texas to Ohio and West Virginia along a stalled boundary. As the ridge began to retreat eastward, a cold front slowly progressed through Central Alabama on April 6, with an all-hazards weather event unfolding. Slow moving thunderstorms from early morning to late afternoon resulted in flooding issues across northwestern counties and the Birmingham, Montgomery, and Auburn/Opelika areas. Additionally, two brief tornadoes were confirmed, and there were a few isolated reports of hail and wind damage. Late that evening, a motorist in Hale County drove into a downed tree, resulting in a fatality.

A potent shortwave trough dove southeastward from Missouri into the Tennessee Valley during the day and evening of April 10. Storms began firing over West Tennessee during the afternoon, moving southeasterly in conjunction with northwest flow aloft. Meanwhile, a pre-existing boundary was draped across north central Alabama, leftover from convection over Tennessee that morning. More storms began firing along this boundary during the late afternoon and evening hours, initially posing a hail threat. Up to golf ball-size hail fell across Etowah, Cherokee, and Blount counties, with steep mid-level lapse rates in place. Storms later grew upscale into a wind threat by sunset, with scattered pockets of wind damage across several counties.

Then, a secondary batch of thunderstorms, merging at times with the original thunderstorms further south yielded a widespread swath of damaging winds from the northwest tip of Alabama, hard hitting the Shoals/Quad Cities metro area, then pushing through Morgan into Marshall Counties while another wave of wind spread from Madison through Jackson into DeKalb Counties. Numerous trees and power lines were knocked down in this swath, many landing on homes and vehicles, resulting in at least 3 injuries in the Sheffield, Decatur and Hartselle areas. Other more sporadic wind damage was reported further north. The damaging winds resulted in 20000-30000 without power for a period of time in northwest into north central Alabama. Around 250 damage reports were received from this event in north Alabama.

Numerous uprooted and snapped large hardwood and softwood trees occurred at this location. Some patches were rather significant snapping; however, just not enough to warrant a higher rating. A single wide manufactured home was rolled at this location; however, the home was not tied down and sitting on the side of the hill. As a result, a lower bound estimate was given for this damage. The tornado likely continued northeast into the woods where survey crews were unable to reach.
