Trained spotter reported damage near the intersection of FM 3073 and Highway 16, southwest of Hebbronville. Travel trailers, portable buildings and trees were blown over.

A cold front moved across Deep South Texas during the early morning hours of April 4th. Higher dewpoints and steep mid level lapse rates provided some potential for convection along the front. Shower and thunderstorms developed along the front and a few cells became severe as they were approaching the northern ranchlands of Jim Hogg County. Strong winds were reported to have caused damage to travel trailers, portable buildings, and trees southwest of Hebbronville.
