TCOON site at Baffin Bay reported a 40 knot thunderstorm wind gust.

**A 500 mb low/inverted trough over northeast Mexico extended into the Rio Grande Valley, and brought abundant low to mid-level moisture across the western Gulf of Mexico. Cluster of shower and thunderstorms over the lower Texas gulf waters moved north northwest across the waters early in the day.**

TCOON site at Rincon del San Jose reported a 34 knot wind gust.

**A northward moving outflow boundary tapped into available moisture and produced a line of showers and thunderstorms that raced north along the coast and across the lower Texas coastal waters.**
