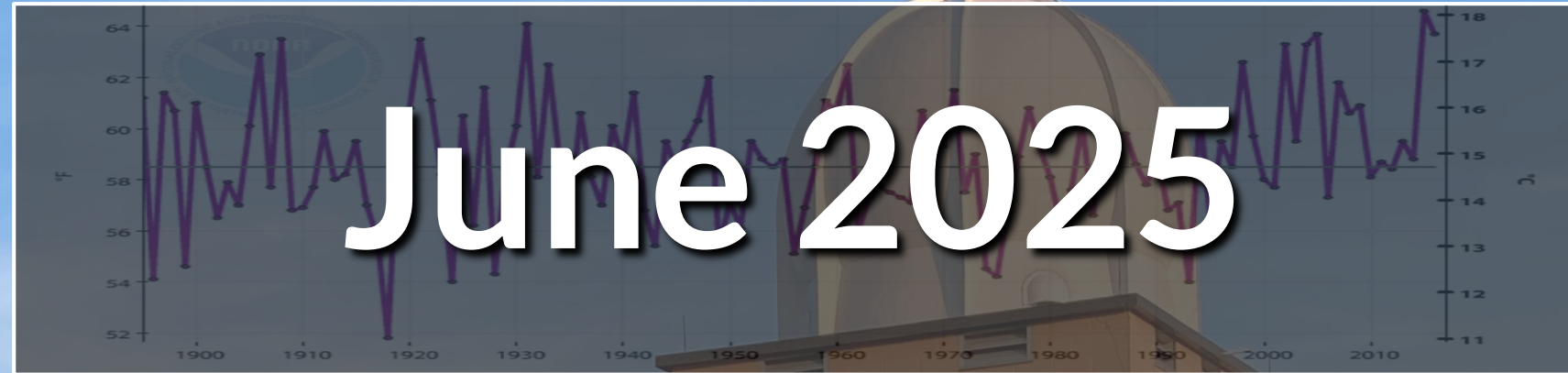

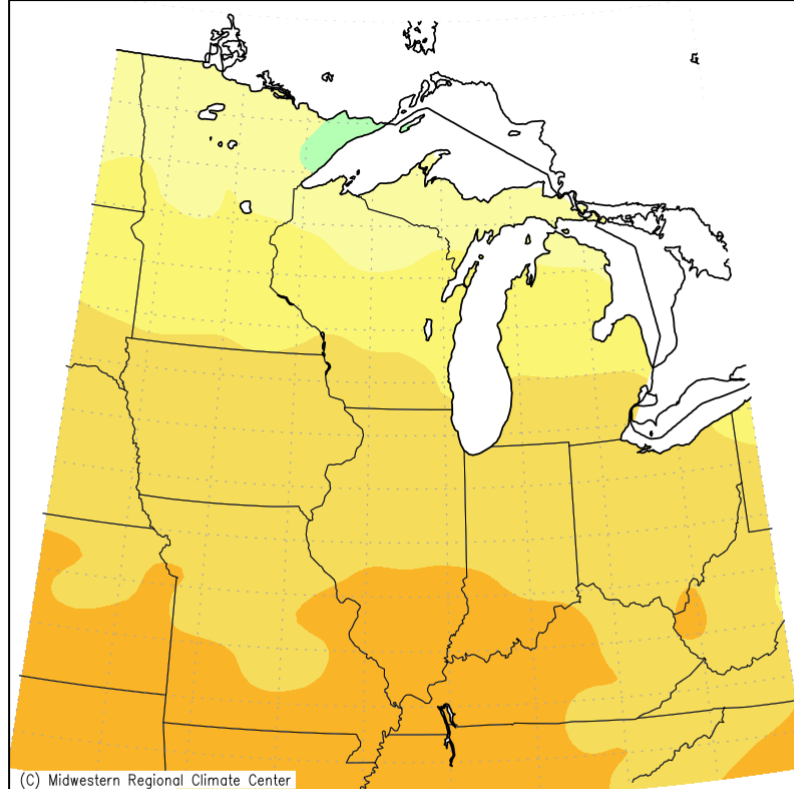

Average Temperature (left) & Departure from Average (right)

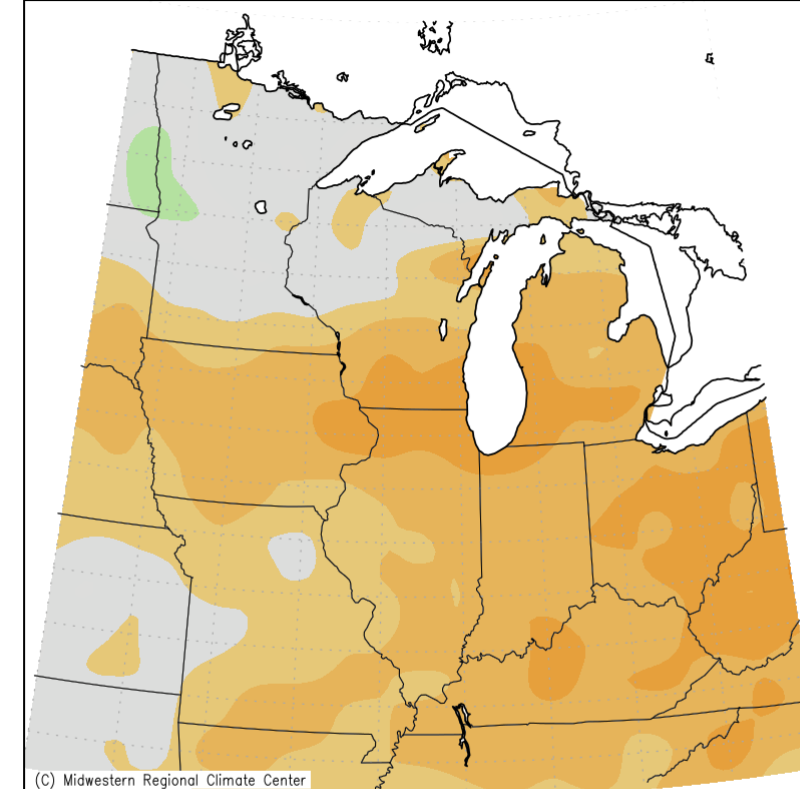

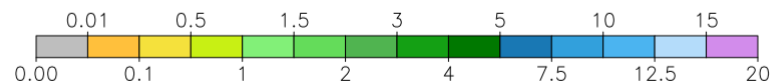
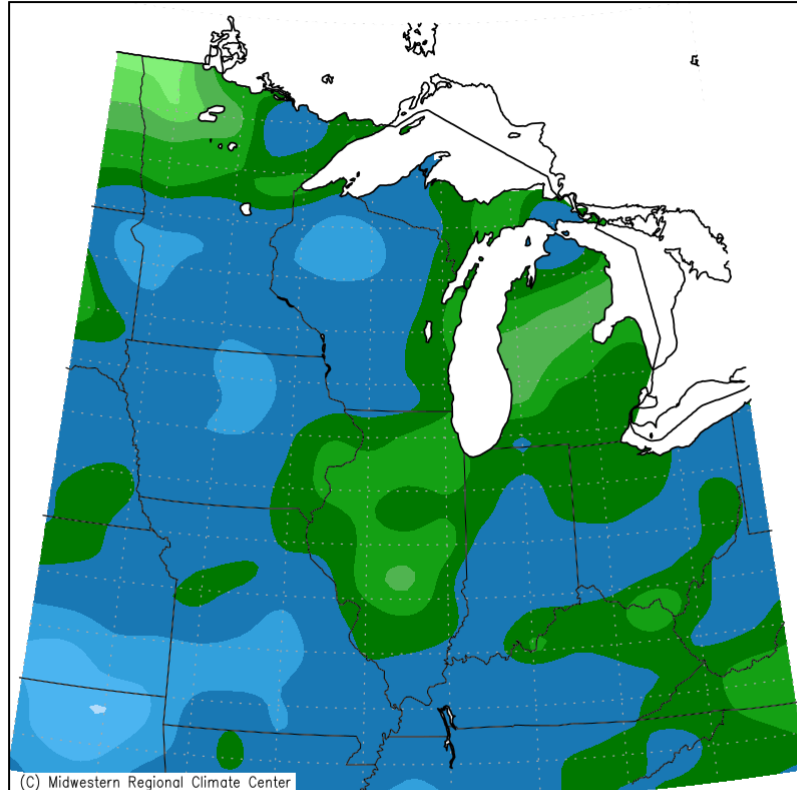

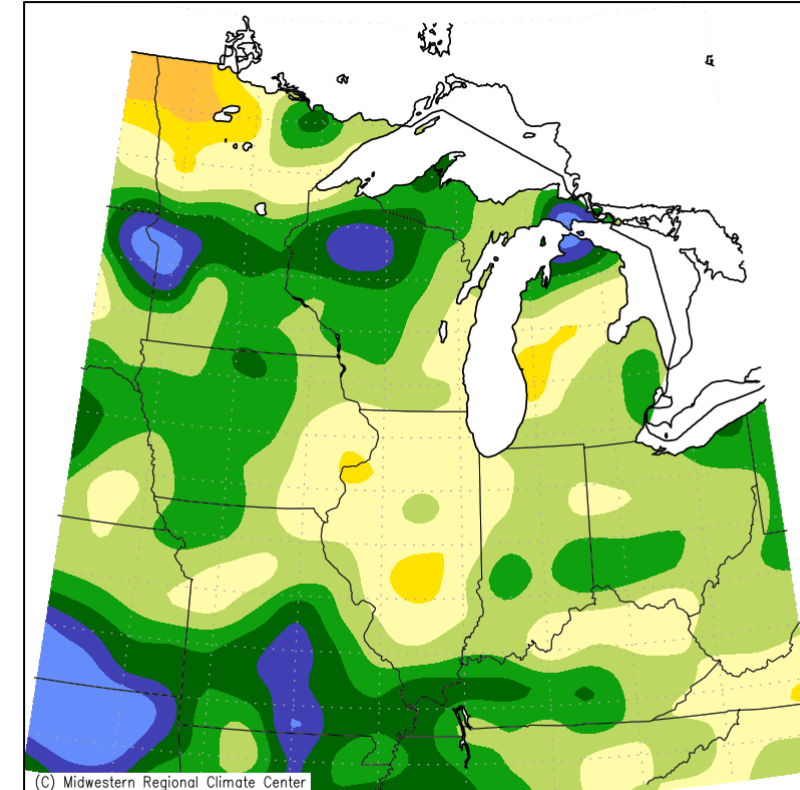
Total Monthly Precipitation (*left*) & Percent of Mean (*right*)

June 1, 2025 to June 30, 2025

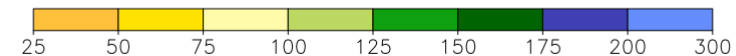
