

CoCoRaHS – Entering Multiple “Zero Precip” Days

Here in the Desert Southwest, you are likely to go long stretches with no precipitation, especially in the Winter and Spring months. If you don't get up every morning to enter your “0.00” precip, you are forgiven!

However, if there is precipitation in the wider area, your “Zeroes” are just as important since they help define the areal extent of precipitation.

Either way, CoCoRaHS makes it very easy to “catch up” on entering zeroes...

1.) From the CoCoRaHS homepage, click on “My Data” on the top menu.

2.) Next, click on “Monthly Zeroes” on the left menu, under the header “Enter My New Reports.”

4.) Then, simply click on the checkboxes on the calendar for each day with Zero Precipitation, then click “Submit” and you're done!
