Executive Order

PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, Indiana winters often bring snow, ice, strong winds and freezing temperatures, which create dangerous travel conditions, threaten lives and property, and disrupt schools, businesses, and essential services; and
- WHEREAS, Hoosiers have experienced severe winter storms throughout the state's history, at times requiring federal disaster assistance, and such storms have caused extended power outages, dangerous road conditions and widespread disruption; and
- WHEREAS, the Indiana Department of Homeland Security, the National Weather Service, the American Red Cross, state agencies, local officials and first responders work together to prepare for, respond to and recover from the impacts of severe winter weather; and
- WHEREAS, preparedness efforts such as creating emergency kits, developing family communication plans, winterizing homes and vehicles, and staying informed of forecasts and alerts are essential to reducing risk and keeping Hoosiers safe during winter storms; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to encourage all Indiana residents to prepare for winter hazards and to recognize the vital role of emergency personnel and organizations in protecting communities

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mike Braun, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim November 9th-15th, 2025 as

WINTER WEATHER PREPAREDNESS WEEK

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
