Scattered to Numerous T'storm Coverage This Week

- Main Hazards: Strong Wind Gusts, Frequent Lightning, and Heavy Rainfall/Localized Flooding



Moderate Risk of Rip Currents through Midweek at All Area Beaches



Hot and Humid Conditions Continue through Late This Week

- **Heat Advisory for Beach Communities this Afternoon**
- Daily Peak Heat Index Values of 105° to 110° Each Afternoon
