


Winter Storm Continues Into Saturday

Winter Weather Headlines Remain in Effect Through Saturday Morning

Key Messages:

- Snow has begun across ALL of Eastern Kentucky.
- Most accumulations will occur this evening and tonight.
- The snow will be drier across northern portions of the forecast area.
- Winter Storm Warnings remain in effect for the whole area.
- Confidence in significant accumulations remains higher further south and west.
- If you must travel, please exercise caution, as hazardous driving conditions are possible.






Winter Storm Continues Into Saturday

Additional Snow Accumulations Through Saturday, 1/11/25

Key Messages:

- Along and Southwest of the Hal Rogers Parkway/KY-80, an additional 3-5 inches of snow are expected.
- Further north, an additional 2-4 inches of snow are expected.
- Mesoscale banding may locally enhance snow totals area-wide.
 - The best chances for this are later this evening near the Tennessee state line.
 - We will be closely monitoring radar trends for this through the night.
- Weak downsloping has been observed in far eastern Kentucky, which may locally reduce accumulations on the leeward side of the higher terrain there.






Winter Storm Continues Into Saturday

Snow Tapers Off from West to East, But Flurries Linger

Key Messages:

- The heaviest snow will end from west to east early Saturday AM.
- Due to winds shifting to an upslope orientation, lighter snow and flurries should linger across the eastern counties into Saturday afternoon.
- In many places, there is still snow/ice on the ground from previous events.
 - Please do not measure new accumulations on top of old ones.
- Temperatures on Saturday will remain near or below freezing, so snow will stick around.
- Warmer temperatures and clearing skies on Sunday will foster some degree of melting, but not all snow is expected to clear by Monday.
