Subject: Discontinuation of river forecast services for the Kankakee River gauge near Kouts, Indiana

Effective December 15, 2020, river forecast services for the Kankakee River gauge near Kouts, Indiana, (NWS identifier KTSI3) will be discontinued. Flood warnings will continue to be issued for river flooding along the affected portions of the Kankakee River in Jasper and Porter Counties, Indiana, but will be based upon the river gauge at Dunns Bridge, Indiana (NWS identifier DBRI3).

On and after December 15th, the Dunns Bridge gauge will represent the Kankakee River from US-421 south of La Crosse downstream to near I-65 and De Motte. River forecasts will be issued when this location has reached, or is expected to reach, action stage.
