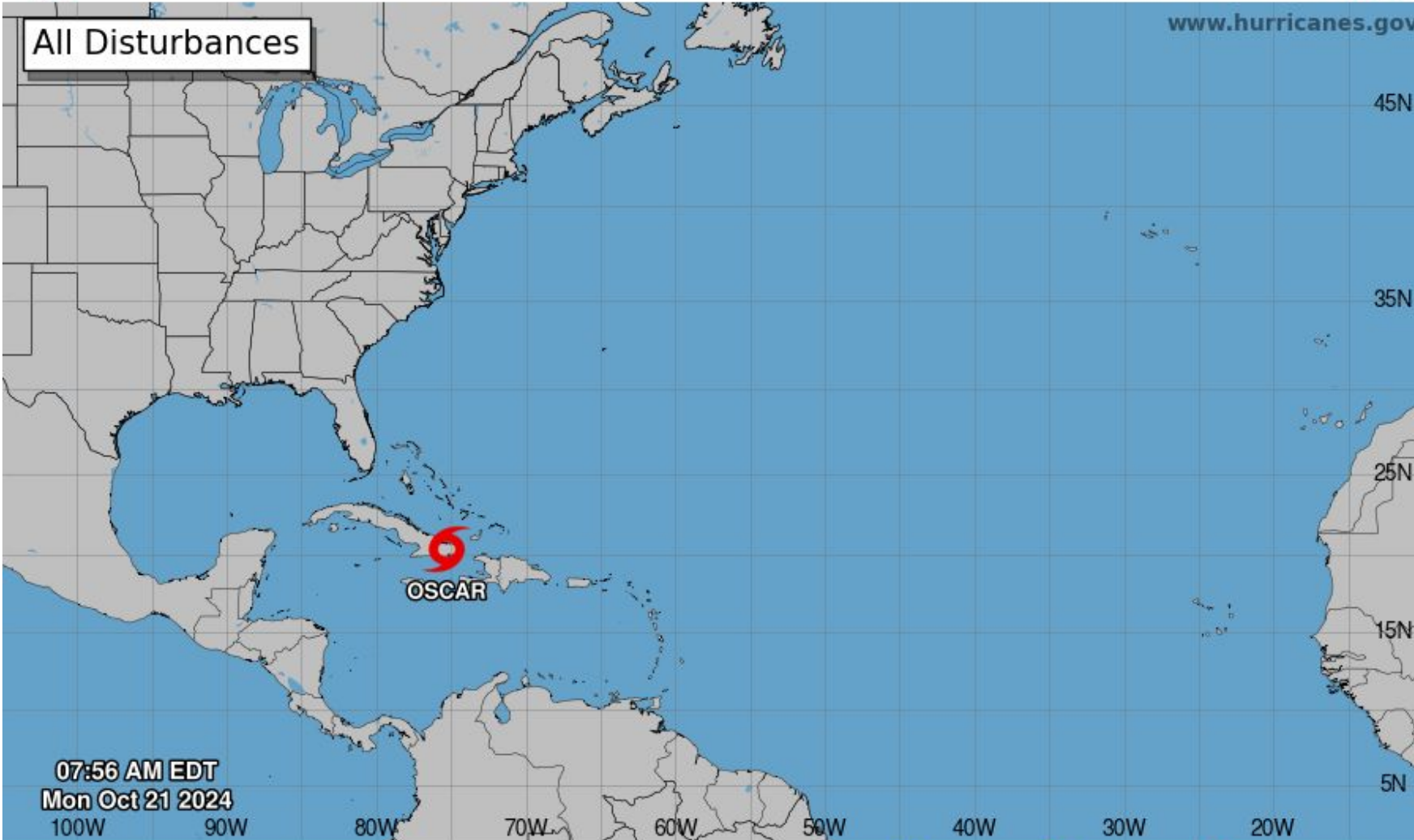

Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook National Hurricane Center Miami, Florida

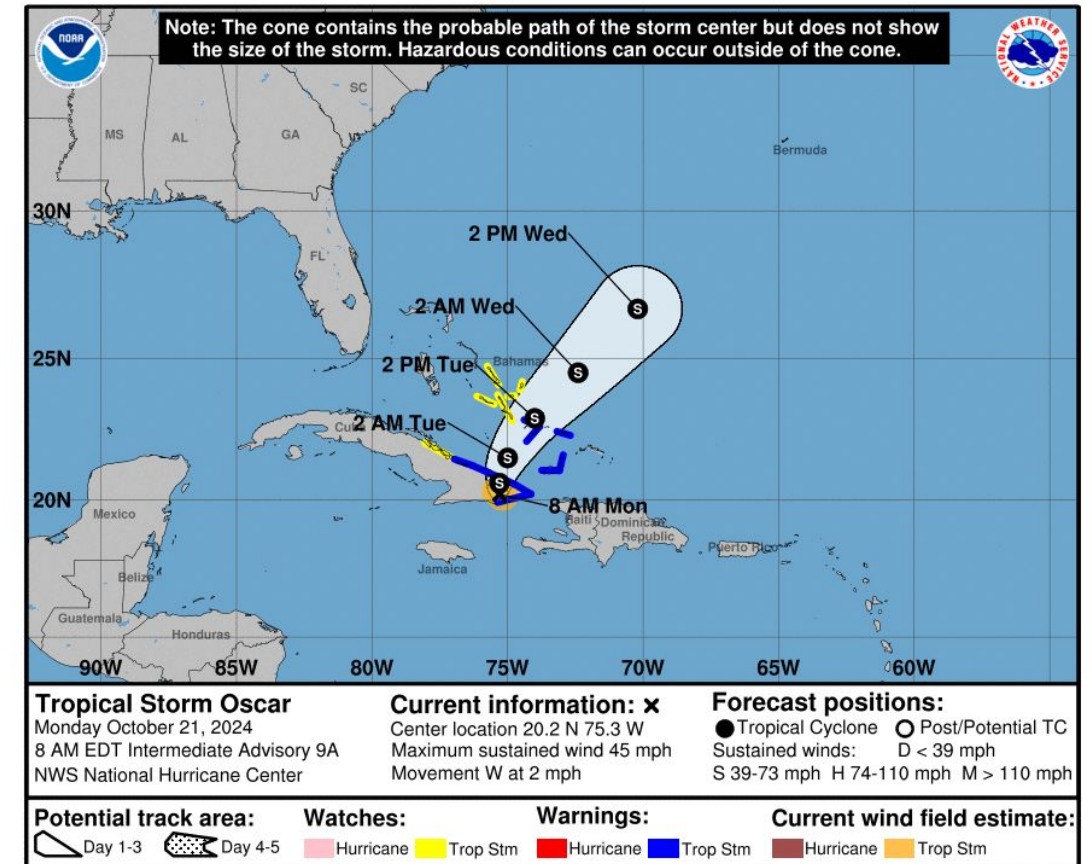


Current Disturbances and Seven-Day Cyclone Formation Chance: < 40% 40-60% > 60%

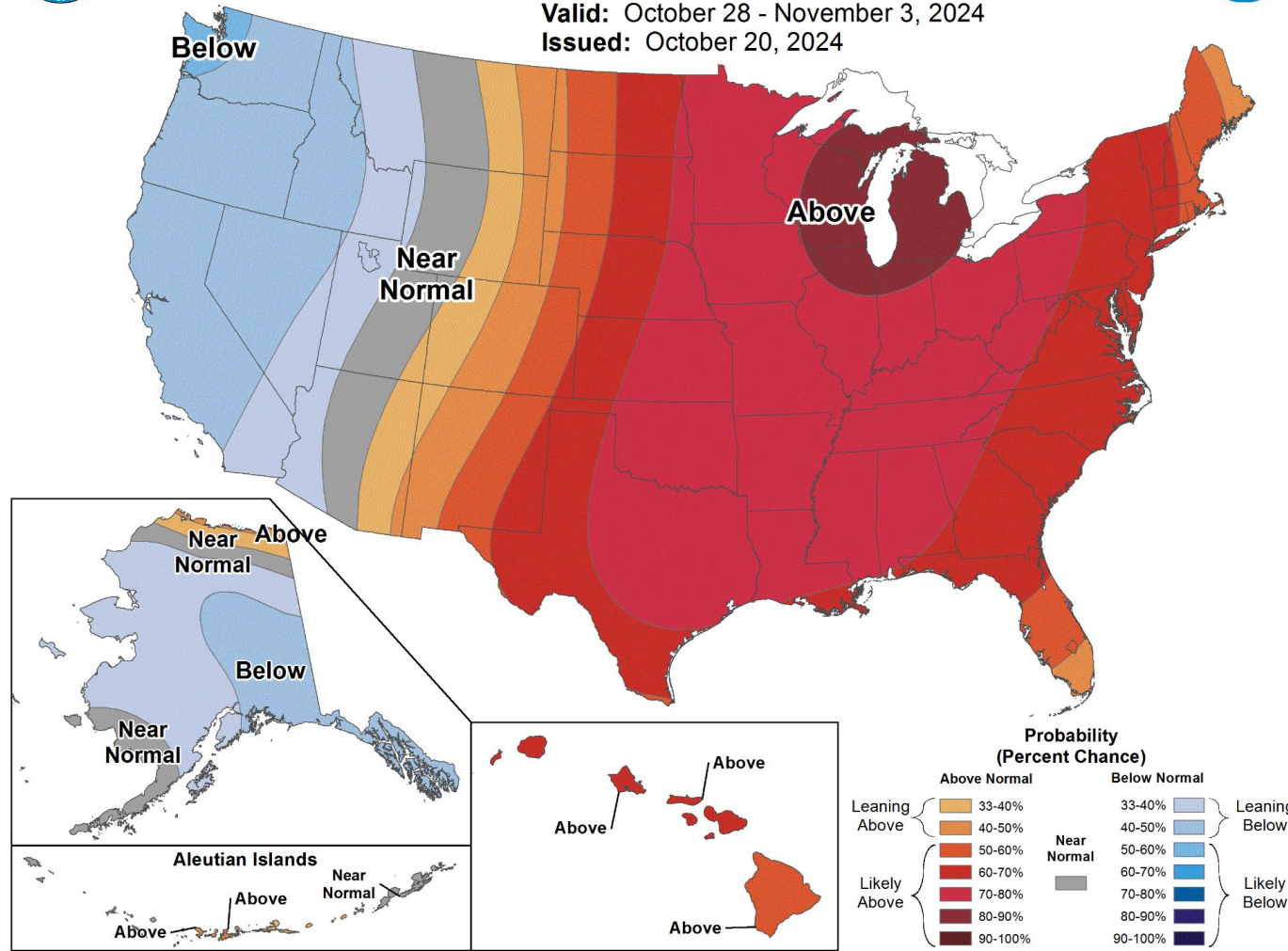

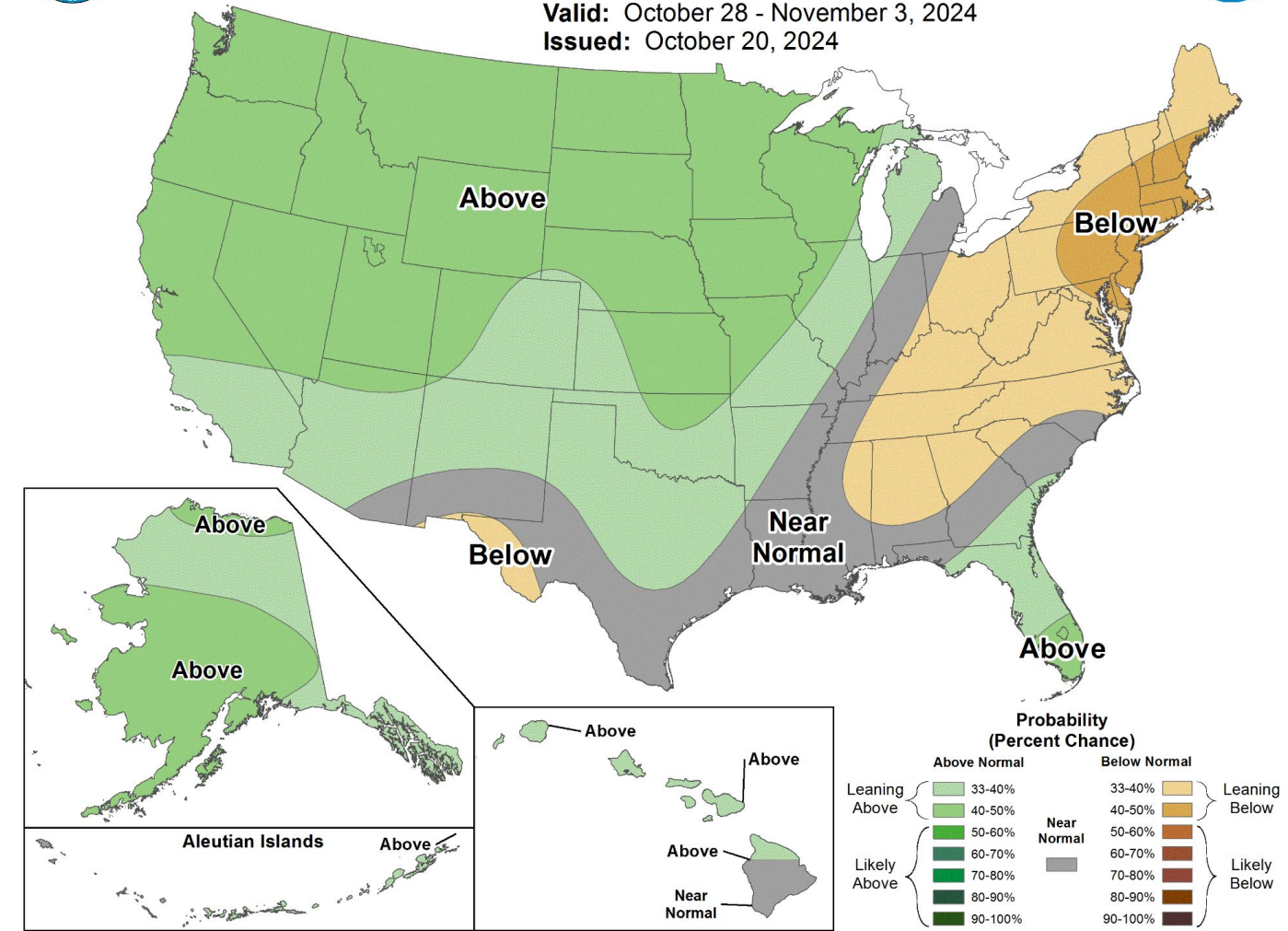
Above normal temperatures likely

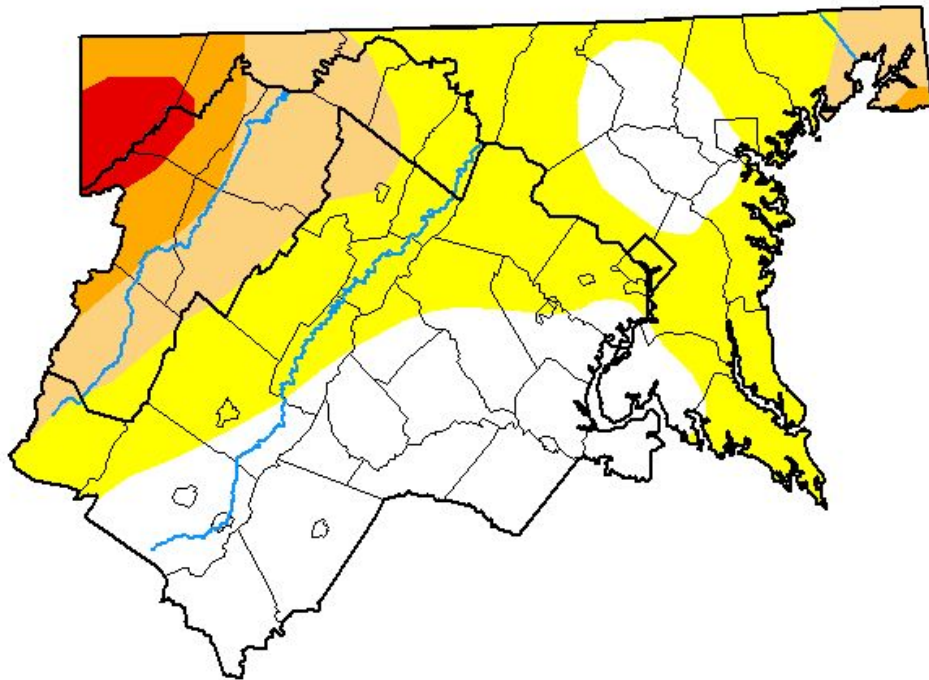
