
 Thunderstorms are expected, a few of which will be capable of producing localized damaging wind gusts and scattered instances of flash flooding.






Severe Storms / Flooding Possible

This afternoon and evening






- Threats

 - 2 PM and 10 PM






Severe Storms / Flooding Possible

Tuesday afternoon and evening






- Threats

A dry, seasonable 4th expected




Forecast Weather Features 8 AM Friday


- High pressure expected

Above Normal Precipitation



- Abnormally dry conditions remain for the tidewater region of MD






National Hurricane Center Outlook
