Midland International Airport finished the month of April below normal agai with only 0.51 inches of rainfall. This is 0.22 inches below the climate normal. Much of the rainfall for the entire Hydrologic Service Area (HSA) fell on 4 separate days: the 10<sup>th</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, and 28<sup>th</sup> with the heaviest rainfall on the 10<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> as severe weather moved through the north and northeastern Permian Basin. This continues to leave a large portion of the HSA without measurable precipitation further fueling the fire weather concerns across the area as drought continues to impact the area. With the heaviest rainfall in the northeastern portions of the HSA, an RVS was issued for locations along the Colorado River where brief rises were expected on the 24<sup>th</sup>, but flooding was not expected nor did it occur.
