98 locations reported rainfall for the month of December, for an HSA average of 0.74".

Normal December precipitation for Midland International Air and Space Port is 0.60". Total precipitation for the airport for 2016 was 15.18", or 0.58" above normal.

Despite lack of rain in December, drought conditions stayed the same or improved slightly in West Texas and Southeast New Mexico. As of December 27th, in Southeast New Mexico, only a small portion of the Guadalupe Mountains in southwest Eddy County was abnormally dry. The rest of Southeast New Mexico was out of drought. In West Texas, no drought conditions were noted.
