The Inspiration – Fire Prevention


In 1937 President Roosevelt kicked off a national campaign featuring Uncle Sam as a forest ranger. "Your Forests – Your Fault – Your Loss" was a powerful message for the public.

Smokey Bear An American Icon!

 The Forest Service chose the name to be Smokey Bear, after "Smokey" Joe Martin, who had been the Assistant Chief of the New York City Fire Department. On August 9, 1944, the first poster of Smokey Bear was produced.








