Operational Data from August 16 to August 18, 2025

The NWS Alaska Region is notifying the public that some data and services
will be unavailable starting Saturday, August 16, 2025 around 9:00 am
until Monday August 18, 2025 at 9:00 am, Alaska Daylight Time (AKDT).

Public data and services that will be affected during this time include:

- Some surface and hydrologic observations may be unavailable.
- Some ship observations will be unavailable.
- AUG 17 0000z and 1200z (3:00 AM and 3:00 PM AKDT) and AUG 18
0000z (3:00 PM AKDT) upper-air observations (excluding
Barrow and Anchorage) will be unavailable.
- NOAA Weather Radio at the following sites will be out of
service: Barrow, Kotzebue, Nome, Bethel, Saint Paul,
Unalaska, Cold Bay and Yakutat.
- Experimental Alaska Aviation Guidance (AAG) at
<https://www.weather.gov/arh/aag> will be unavailable.

Weather forecasts and warnings and tsunami information will continue to
be available on the internet at <https://www.weather.gov/> and
<https://www.tsunami.gov>. There may be other unexpected impacts during
this time. We thank you for your patience and will return all services to
operational status as quickly as possible after the power returns.
