Subject: Changes to Public and Marine Weather Zones for NWS Weather
Forecast Office New Orleans/Baton Rouge, LA, effective March 3, 2026

Effective on Tue, March 3, 2026, at 3:00 PM Central Standard Time (CST),
2100 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC), 2100 Coordinated Universal Time
(UTC), the NWS Weather Forecast Office in Slidell, Louisiana (LIX) will
change Public, Fire, and Marine Weather Forecast Zones encompassing
Terrebonne, Lafourche, St. Charles, Jefferson, and Plaquemines Parishes
in southeast Louisiana, and adjacent coastal waters. After this change,
all public, fire and marine forecasts and related products will use the
new zone numbers and names shown in Table 2 below.

If March 3, 2026 is declared a Critical Weather Day, this implementation
will be postponed to March 4, 2026 at 2100 UTC.

These changes are intended to provide increased flexibility and improved
accuracy of forecast, watch, warning, and advisory products in the
public, fire, and marine weather programs. Thirteen existing zones are
being reconfigured into 19 separate zones to optimize issuance of land
and marine hazard products across coastal southeast Louisiana, and to
better differentiate between areas inside and outside of the Hurricane
and Storm Damage Risk Reduction System levees in St. Charles Parish.
