SUBJECT: Implementation of Temporary Terminal Aerodrome Forecast (TAF)  
for North Perry Airport in Pembroke Pines, FL (KHWO): Effective June 13,  
2026

Effective June 13, 2026 at 1200 Universal Coordinated Time (UTC), the NWS  
office in Miami, FL will begin temporary TAF service for KHWO to support  
the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the aviation community  
during the World Cup. After that date, routine and updated TAFs will be  
issued 24 hours a day until July 19 at 0000 UTC.

NWS personnel/offices will need to add the following identifier to their  
communications systems to receive the temporary TAF:
