

A tornado formed in eastern Montgomery county at Port Royal Road and Sandlerville Road and was in Montgomery county for 1/2 mile and 200 yards wide. The tornado did minor damage to 5 or 6 homes, trees were blown and a TVA tower was blown down. The tornado entered western Robertson county and did damage at Jo Byrns Elementary School which is just east of Adams. The tornado lifted back up at 1.5 miles northwest of Cedar Hill.

Preliminary damage estimates caused by the tornadoes are as follows:

Hermitage - 10 million

Davidson County...At least 100 million dollars in Nashville alone. - Hermitage - 10 million

Wilson County...4 to 5 million dollars

Giles County...100,000 thousand dollars.

Maury County...4 million dollars for residential and commercial property, churches and schools.

Pickett County...10 million dollars.
