


## **Bottom Line Up Front**

Significant snowfall today into this evening

#### **Key Messages**

- Impactful winter storm with significant snow amounts will affect the entire region today into this evening.
- Travel disruptions are likely! It is recommended to stay home or make alternative arrangements if possible. Roads will be slick!
- Snowfall totals of 4 to 7 inches are expected by tonight.
- Highest snow totals will be in southeast Missouri, far west Kentucky and extreme southwest Illinois.
- Lowest snowfall totals will be in portions of southwest Indiana and northwest Kentucky.










### **Approximate Arrival Time of Accumulating Snow**

Snow will spread from west to east through mid-morning, then continue through the day


These are the estimated starting times of accumulating snowfall this morning.

Precipitation will be in the form of all snow.











Western Kentucky: 7 AM to 2 PM CST


Southern Illinois: 7 AM to 2 PM CST



#### **Key Messages**

- Significant snowfall can be expected through late this afternoon into this evening.
- Snow accumulations of around 4-7 inches or more are expected in the warning area.
- The snow will accumulate quickly and will lead to significant travel difficulties today into tonight.
- Temperatures are expected to remain near to below freezing throughout the event, and precipitation will be all snow.

## AFTER A WINTER STORM

- While in clean up mode, be alert for falling tree branches caked with snow and/or ice.
- Use caution walking to avoid slips and falls.
- Check latest road conditions before going out.
- Use extra caution driving if there is any residual snow and/or ice.
- Shoveling can be a strain on your heart move small amounts at a time and take frequent breaks.



# SHOVEL SMART!



Shoveling heavy, wet snow can cause back injuries and heart attacks. Don't push yourself!



**Dress warmly,** making sure to cover your head, fingers and toes.



**Stay hydrated,** but avoid heavy meals right before or after shoveling.



Move only small amounts of snow with each pass of the shovel.



Take frequent breaks.
Stop shoveling entirely if you feel exhausted!
