






OCTOBER: Wettest October Ever Recorded at DCA, BWI & IAD



Monthly Highlights

- Above normal temperatures with record October rainfall across area
- First time driest month on record followed by wettest month on record in Washington
- Monthly precipitation totals generally between 9"-12" throughout region, resulting in the wettest month since September 1999 at all three major airports
- Two day deluge on 7th-8th soaked area with 7"-9" of precipitation and resulted in flooded roads, basements, scattered power outages, and evacuations from some homes in Harford County, MD, where up to a foot of rain was recorded
- * BWI's monthly precipitation total of 9.23" was 6th wettest month of all-time; IAD's 9.22" of rain was its 8th wettest month on record
- Storm system on 25th produced more than an inch of rain in many areas and first snow of season in VA/MD mountains, with up to 12" in Garrett County, MD, and 3"-5" in Shenandoah Mountains.
- Normal annual precipitation exceeded at BWI with 42.58" recorded through October
- Five days with highs at or above 80°F at DCA and IAD
- Fifth consecutive month with above normal temperatures at all three airports
- First October without a reading of 32°F or lower at IAD since 1984
