







SEPTEMBER: Record Dryness Across Area; Second Warmest September On Record at IAD





Monthly Highlights

- Driest September on record in Washington and at Dulles, 6th at BWI
- Only 3 days with measurable (> 0.01") precipitation at DCA
- Fourth driest month ever recorded in Washington
- ♦ Sixth driest August-September (2.44") on record in Washington, driest August-September since 1998
- Second warmest September on record at IAD, 5th at BWI and in Washington (warmest since 1998)
- At or above normal highs on 27 days at DCA
- Most 90°F+ highs at DCA since 1998 (7 days)
- ♦ Highs of 80°F+ on 26 days, the most since at least 1948
- U.S. Department of Agriculture declares several Virginia counties including Loudoun, Fauquier and Clarke agricultural disaster areas, according to press reports.
- Many areas record longest spell with no measurable rainfall (August 29-September 25) since October 17-November 19, 2001
