






## JUNE 2007: Driest June in Washington Since 1991 Above Normal Temperatures Across Area



## **June Highlights**

- Above normal temperatures throughout area with positive departures of +1.6F at DCA, +1.9F at BWI and +3.5F at IAD
- Highs at or above 90°F on 8 days at IAD; 7 days at DCA and BWI
- ₹ Earliest occurrence of year, 18th-19th, of temperatures at or above 95°F at DCA on 2 consecutive days since 1998
- ♦ DCA and IAD recorded 3 days with highs at or above 95°F, BWI 2 days
- ♦ BWI and IAD soar to 97°F on 27<sup>th</sup>, hottest June reading since 1998
- ◆ DCA recorded 11 minimums at or above 70°F, including 25<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup>
- Above normal temperatures in Washington for 12th month of last 16
- Subnormal rainfall at all three major airports; DCA records 1.38", driest June since 1991, 1.27"
- Remnants of Tropical Storm Barry brought more than an inch of rain to area on 3rd, 1.18" at BWI
- Thunderstorms produce wind damage, locally heavy rainfall, hail and dangerous lightning across portions of metro area on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>
- 💎 Thunderstorm winds gust to 61 mph were recorded at IAD on 13th and 60 mph at BWI on 21st
- One lightning fatality reported in Prince Georges County, MD, on 27<sup>th</sup>
