




MAY 2007: Driest on Record at Washington Dulles SPRING 2007: Warm and Dry Across Area



May Highlights

- ♣ Positive temperatures departures observed at all three major airports: +2.2°F, at DCA, +2.6°F at BWI, & +3.8°F at IAD
- TAD measured 16 days with highs at or above 80°F; DCA and IAD, 14 such days
- Area recorded first 90°F or greater reading of the year on 26th; BWI recorded 3 days with 90°F+ highs, IAD, 2 days
- Many locations across Loudoun County, VA, and Montgomery and Anne Arundel Counties in MD record less than an inch of rain
- CCA recorded only 4 days with measurable precipitation; monthly precipitation total of 0.94" at BWI was 4th driest on record
- 💎 Thunderstorm wind damage, including numerous downed trees and power lines affected many portions of metro area on 27th
- Thunderstorms dumped 0.93" rainfall at DCA on 10th; storms on 16th knocked out power to more than 45,000 homes and businesses

Seasonal Highlights:

- Seasonal temperature departures of +0.3°F at DCA, +0.7°F at BWI & +1.9°F at IAD
- ♦ Highs at or above normal at DCA on 52 days (57%); highs at or above 80°F on 21 days at DCA
- Third driest Spring on record at IAD
- Lows plummeted to teens at most locations March 6-8; IAD reading of 11°F and BWI low of 14°F were lowest since March 10, 1996
- First March day (7th) with a subfreezing high at DCA since March 9, 1999
- On March 7, about 2" of snow fell across the D.C. area with more than 5" reported in parts of Frederick County, MD
- The show with as much as 8" of snow in Frederick County, MD
- April 5-17 was coldest on record in Washington since 1907, and coldest ever in Baltimore, with daily departures of -10.2°F at DCA, -9.2°F at BWI, and -9.2°F at IAD
- On April 5-9, highs dropped below 50°F at the three major airports, the first such occurrence in Washington since 1898
- Major storm system drenched area on April 14-15 with more than 2" of rain, flooded roadways
- On April 16, high winds followed storm with gusts 50-60 mph
