

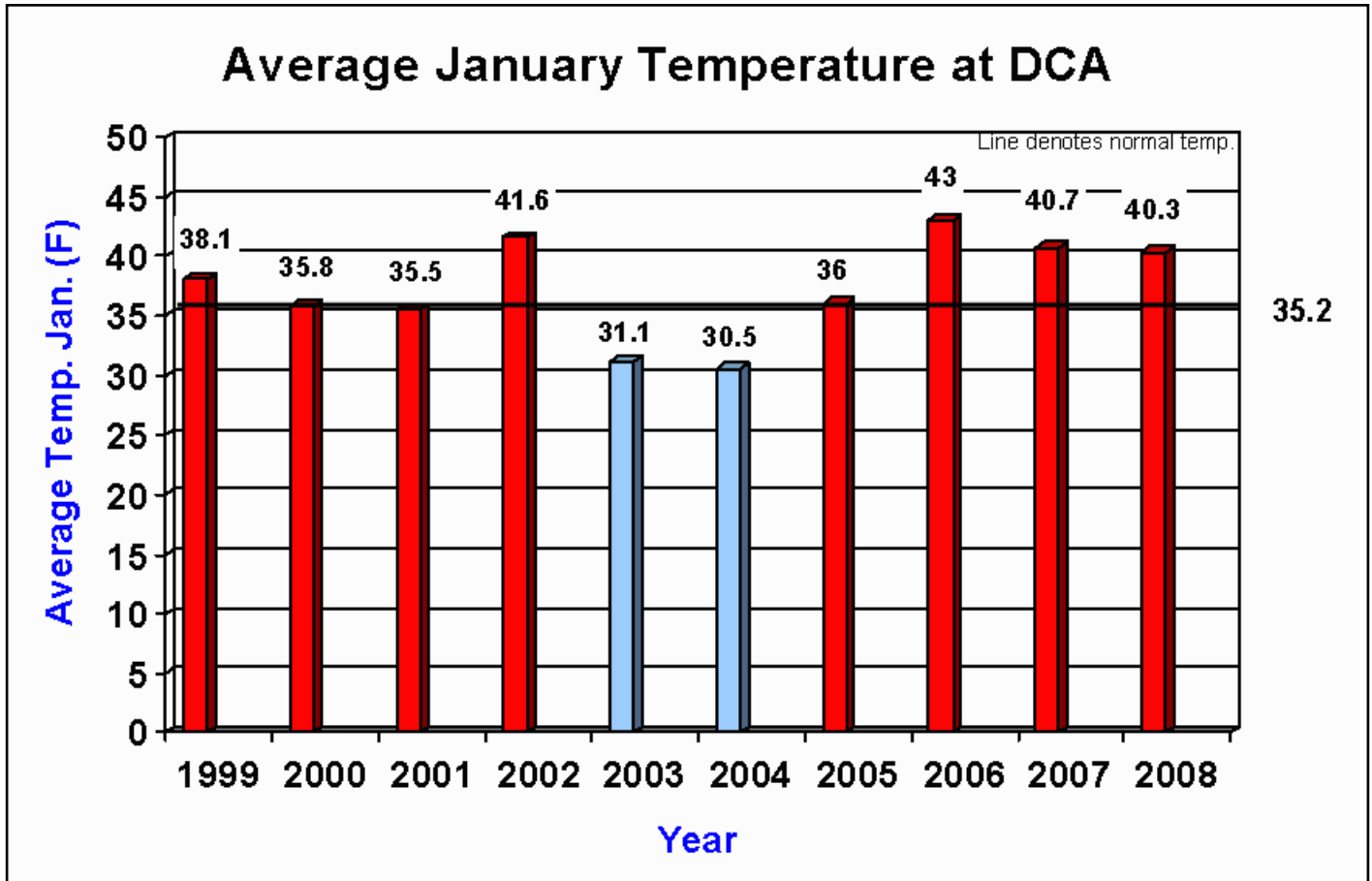

PREcipitation Summary and Temperature Observations  
For the Washington, DC & Baltimore, MD Area



## JANUARY 2008: Dry, Mild with Subnormal Snowfall Across the Washington/Baltimore Area



### January Highlights

- ✦ Well above normal temperatures across the area with departures +5.1°F at DCA, 3.1°F at BWI and 3.8°F at IAD
- ✦ Record highs of 73°F at DCA, and 70°F at BWI and IAD on 8<sup>th</sup>
- ✦ Max readings more than 20°F above normal from 7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> with highs from the upper 60s to lower 70s
- ✦ Only 1 day with subfreezing highs at DCA (21<sup>st</sup>); 2 such days at BWI and IAD
- ✦ Wind chill readings as low as 6°F at IAD on 20<sup>th</sup> as gusty winds accompany readings in the 30s
- ✦ Fifth driest January on record at IAD, 9<sup>th</sup> driest at DCA, 12<sup>th</sup> driest at Baltimore
- ✦ Months' only significant snowfall occurs on 17<sup>th</sup> with amounts up to 6" in some locations impacting travel and transportation
- ✦ Subnormal snowfall at DCA for January with 1.3"
- ✦ Below normal snowfall at DCA for 8 of last 10 years.
