



AUGUST & SUMMER HIGHLIGHTS:

- Fourth wettest August (8.37") at Ft. Belvoir since records began in 1957.
- Subnormal August temperatures resulted in only the second cooler than normal month in 1990 at DCA.
- Seasonal summer temperatures with no prolonged heat waves (longest stretch of ≥ 90°F at DCA was only 5 days [July 19–23]).
- Wet weekend trend continued through the summer at DCA with only 3 rain-free weekends (June 16–17, July 7–8, August 18–19).
