






PRECIPITATION SUMMARY AND TEMPERATURE OBSERVATIONS FOR THE WASHINGTON, DC & BALTIMORE, MD AREA

JUNE 1990

RELATIVELY DRY JUNE EXCEPT ON THE WEEKENDS (AS USUAL)
AND IN PORTIONS OF CALVERT COUNTY, MARYLAND.



AT WASHINGTON/NATIONAL (DCA):

- Although a relatively dry month, 4 of 5 weekends (including June 30 July 1) had rain.
 The dry weekend of June 16 17 snapped a stretch of 16 consecutive wet weekends.
 Since February, however, 20 of 22 weekends have recorded some precipitation!
- Another month with above normal temperatures (5 of 6 this year). Only May has been cooler than normal. The year with the least number of subnormal monthly temperatures was 1980 with 2 (based upon 1951 – 1980 normals).
