






PRECIPITATION SUMMARY AND TEMPERATURE OBSERVATIONS FOR THE WASHINGTON, DC & BALTIMORE, MD AREA

APRIL 1991

DRIEST APRIL SINCE 1985 AT ALL FIVE AIRPORTS (DCA, IAD, BWI, ADW & DAA) IN THE WASHINGTON/BALTIMORE AREA.



- Seventh consecutive warmer than normal month at DCA.
- Warmest April at DCA, BWI and IAD since 1985.
- Third warmest April on record at IAD.
- Despite relatively dry month, measurable rainfall was recorded on a third of the days, which included two consecutive rainy weekends (13th-14th and 20th-21st) and some rainfall occurred on three of the four weekends.

HIGHLIGHTS:

 While April was placid locally, severe thunderstorms caused extensive damage in Charlestown, WV on April 9th and produced up to 6 inches of rain in Norfolk, VA on April 20th.
