



## OCTOBER 1991

## FIFTH DRIEST JANUARY THROUGH OCTOBER, PERIOD ON RECORD IN WASHINGTON SINCE RECORDS BEGAN IN 1871



## **HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Third driest January—October period at BWI (Total Precipitation: 24.24"; Dep. Normal: -11.09") and fourth driest at IAD (Total Precipitation: 26.79"; Dep. Normal: -7.28");
- Two consecutive weeks (Oct. 18th–31st) without measurable precipitation at DCA;
- Temperatures above normal for the ninth month this calendar year at DCA with warmest January—October period on record at DCA, BWI, and IAD;
- Third consecutive warmer than normal October at DCA.
