



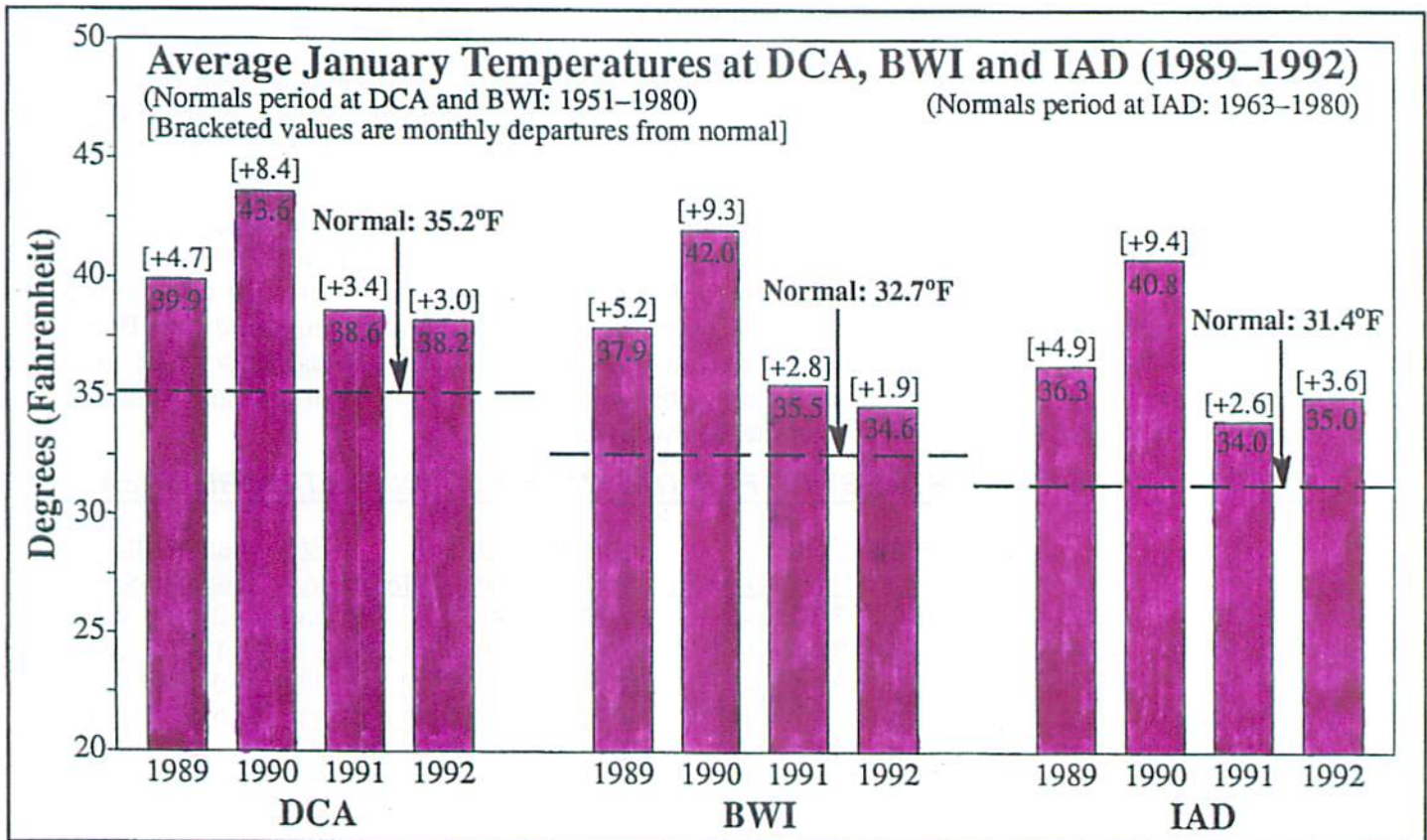

**PRECIPITATION SUMMARY AND TEMPERATURE OBSERVATIONS  
FOR THE WASHINGTON, DC & BALTIMORE, MD AREA**

**JANUARY 1992**

**ABOVE NORMAL TEMPERATURES CONTINUE IN THE  
WASHINGTON/BALTIMORE AREA**



### **HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Sixteenth consecutive warmer than normal month at IAD;
- 15 of last 16 months (and 21 of last 25) with above normal temperatures at DCA and BWI;
- 68% of January (21 days) with above normal average temperatures, including 13 consecutive days (2nd – 14th);
- Fourth consecutive January with below normal snowfall at DCA;
- First January since 1986 with below normal precipitation, and the driest since 1981 at BWI;
- Greatest snowfall amount (3.8" on the 25th) at DCA since December 12 – 13, 1989;
- Lowest temperature at DCA a modest 14°F;
- Only one calendar day (midnight – midnight) this Winter season with sub-freezing temperatures (Jan. 19th).
