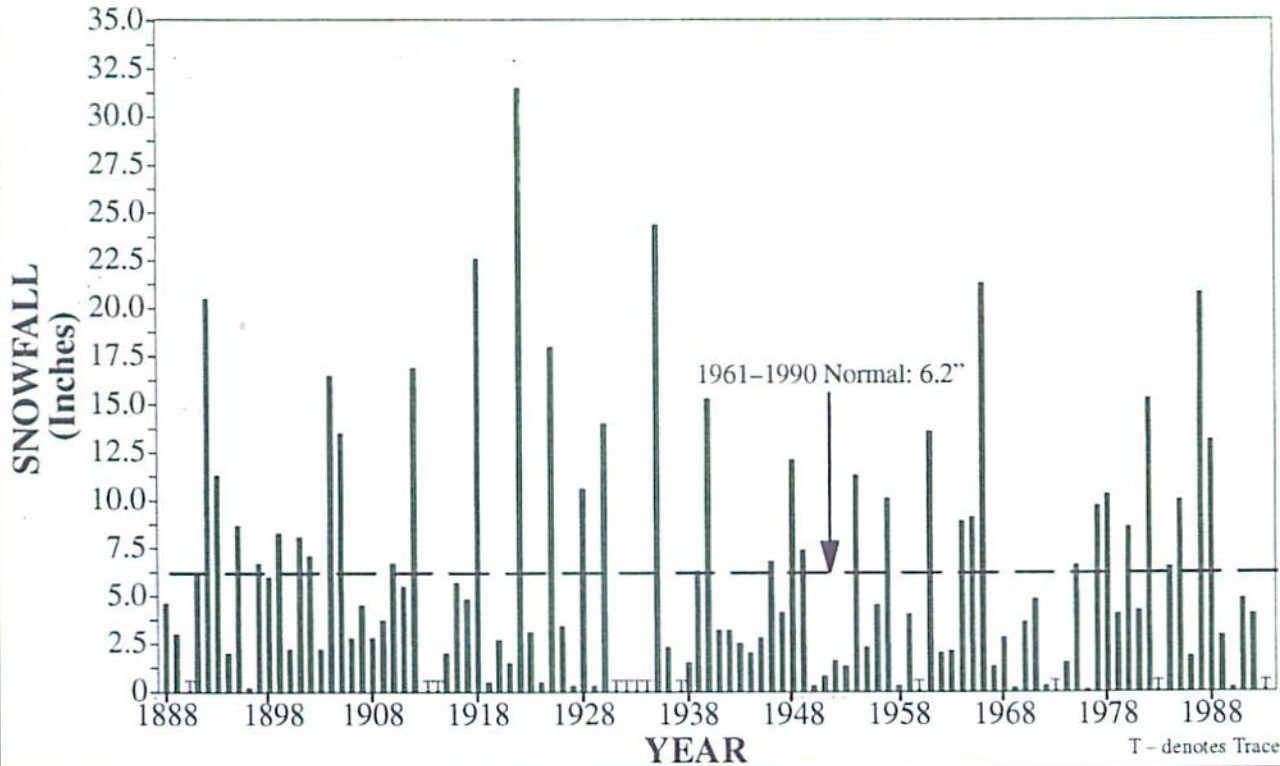

JANUARY HIGHLIGHTS

- Fifth consecutive warmer than normal January at all five airports;
- Third warmest January on record at IAD;
- 25 days (81%) with above normal temperatures at DCA;
- Only one calendar day (midnight-midnight) this Winter with at or below freezing temperatures (Jan. 10th) at DCA;
- Third consecutive warmer than normal month at DCA, BWI, and IAD;
- Fifth consecutive January with subnormal snowfall at DCA, BWI and IAD;
- Only the twelfth January with a trace of snow recorded at Washington/National since snowfall records began in 1888;
- 6 consecutive sunless days (8th-13th) at DCA and 45 cloudy days (73%) for December 1992-January 1993 period.
