WAKULLA, FL...MINOR FLOODING OF OLD FORT ROAD IN ST MARKS, A SMALL PORTION OF RIVERSIDE DRIVE, LIVE OAK ISLAND NEAR THE LIVE OAK ISLAND MARINA, BOTTOMS ROAD IN PANACEA, A SMALL PORTION OF CHICKASAW ROAD IN PANACEA, AND THE END OF MASHES SANDS ROAD.

WALTON, FL...MINOR FLOODING ON FT PANIC ROAD AND COUNTY ROAD 30A IN SANTA ROSA BEACH.

BAY, FL...MINOR FLOODING ON ROGERS AND PIPPIN DRIVE IN PANAMA CITY, AS WELL AS BEACH AND CHERRY ROADS IN THE SOUTHERN PORTION OF THE COUNTY.

FRANKLIN, FL...FLOODING AND DEBRIS FROM STORM SURGE CLOSED ALLIGATOR POINT ROAD. THE END OF WATER ROAD IN APALACHICOLA AT THE BAY WAS UNDERWATER.

GULF, FL...FLOODING FROM STORM SURGE CLOSED INDIAN PASS ROAD. FLOODING WAS REPORTED IN THE STUMPHOLE AREA ON CAPE SAN BLAS, WITH WATER AND DEBRIS OVER THE ROAD.

GULF, FL

A TREE FELL ACROSS HIGHWAY 22. A HOME IN HONEYVILLE WAS DAMAGED BY A FALLEN TREE. THERE WERE A FEW REPORTS OF POWER LINES DOWN. COUNTY SCHOOLS WERE CLOSED NOV 10.

FRANKLIN, FL

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ONE FAMILY WAS EVACUATED FROM ALLIGATOR POINT. A FEW POWER OUTAGES OCCURRED FROM TREES FALLING ON POWER LINES. COUNTY SCHOOLS WERE CLOSED NOV 10.

WAKULLA, FL

A FEW DOWNED TREES AND POWER LINES WERE REPORTED. A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY WAS DECLARED. COUNTY SCHOOLS WERE CLOSED NOV 10.
