Much of far northeastern Oklahoma experienced only a half inch to an inch of precipitation for the month of April 2014. That precipitation was less than 50 percent of the normal monthly precipitation for the area, and in some areas, was only between 10 and 25 percent of normal. Combined with the relatively dry winter that the area experienced, this persistent dry weather resulted in severe drought (D2) conditions developing across portions of Osage, Pawnee, Washington, Nowata, and Craig Counties during the month. Monetary damage estimates resulting from the drought were not available.
