occurred.

Thunderstorm winds estimated at 60 miles an hour blew down large tree limbs.

A cold front moved through the area the night before. It was follow by an upper level system. The combination of the front to the south and the upper level system caused snow to fall across Le Flore county from mid morning into the afernoon. The largest snowfall report received was in Big Cedar where 4.5 inches of snow fell.
